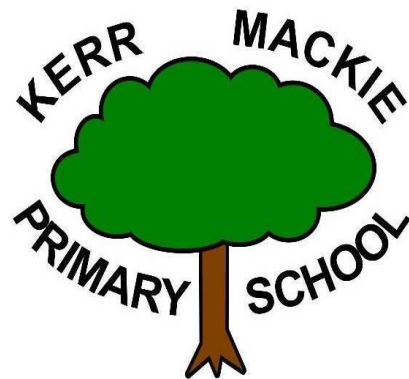

Dear Parent/Carer,

Kerr Mackie Primary School has a very popular breakfast club. Membership of the breakfast club is by invitation only and will be available for your child each day during term time. **There will be a charge per child termly in advance of £11.50 per week (full time) and £2.30 per day for part time places. No refunds will be given if children do not attend.** The cost includes breakfast with 3-6 qualified members of staff.

A variety of breakfast options are available, these include: orange and apple juice, cereal, yoghurt, waffles, pancakes and much more. If your child has any special dietary requirements please indicate on the return slip.

Children have the opportunity to watch DVDs or play with the wide range of activities on offer, these include, badminton, table football, pool, air hockey, construction, play doh etc.

The doors open at 8.00am and food will be served in the community room allowing the children plenty of time to enjoy their breakfast before joining their class for the start of school at 8.45am. If you have any difficulties fitting your work commitments around these times, please speak to Mrs. Cambridge or Mrs. Lal. Please note children need to be brought into the school by parents/carers and not left on the playground.

Our aim is to:

- Get children to school on time
- Provide them with a healthy breakfast to start the day
- Encourage positive behaviour and social skills.
- Develop their understanding of hygiene and food preparation
- Teach them skills to improve their independence
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- Build friendships

Breakfast club rules:

- Arrive quietly, remove coat and place bags in pastoral office
